

Collecting money for The Urology Foundation



If you have organised a fundraising collection, or taken part in a fundraising event, either on your own or as part of a group of friends or with work, thank you. The money you have raised will help The Urology Foundation transform the lives of people with a urology condition or disease through ground-breaking research, training and education.

A little note on collecting money

Don't carry out your own house-to-house collections – it is illegal without a special licence.

Don't collect money in the street or any other public place without a permit from the local authority.

You can hold collections in private venues like supermarkets and shopping centres as long as you have their written permission. TUF can supply you with a letter acknowledging your fundraising event in aid of the charity.

If you are collecting sponsorship or donations make sure it's from people you know and trust. Ensure that children are supervised and don't let them collect money from strangers.

Counting and returning the money raised

Please ensure that money is collected and counted in a secure environment. It is advisable that it is counted and recorded by two unrelated individuals. On completing your collection you should return the money to TUF as soon as possible along with a completed *Money Return Form* (found overleaf).

If using a TUF collection box / bucket it must only be opened by the promoter of the collection on behalf of TUF, or by TUF's fundraising manager.

You **must not** make any deduction from the cash received for The Urology Foundation, unless agreed prior to the collection. If you are unsure please contact Sayara on 020 7713 9538.
